colored pencils

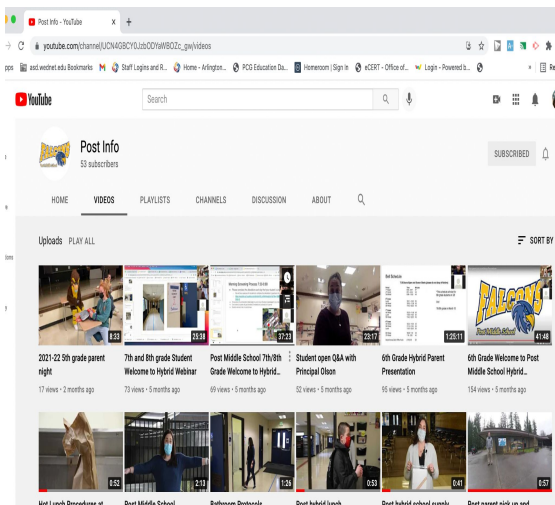
2-3 folders for subjects

Each Day, Your Students will need:

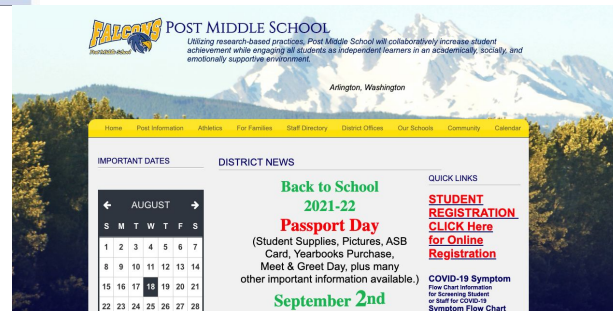
- Backpack

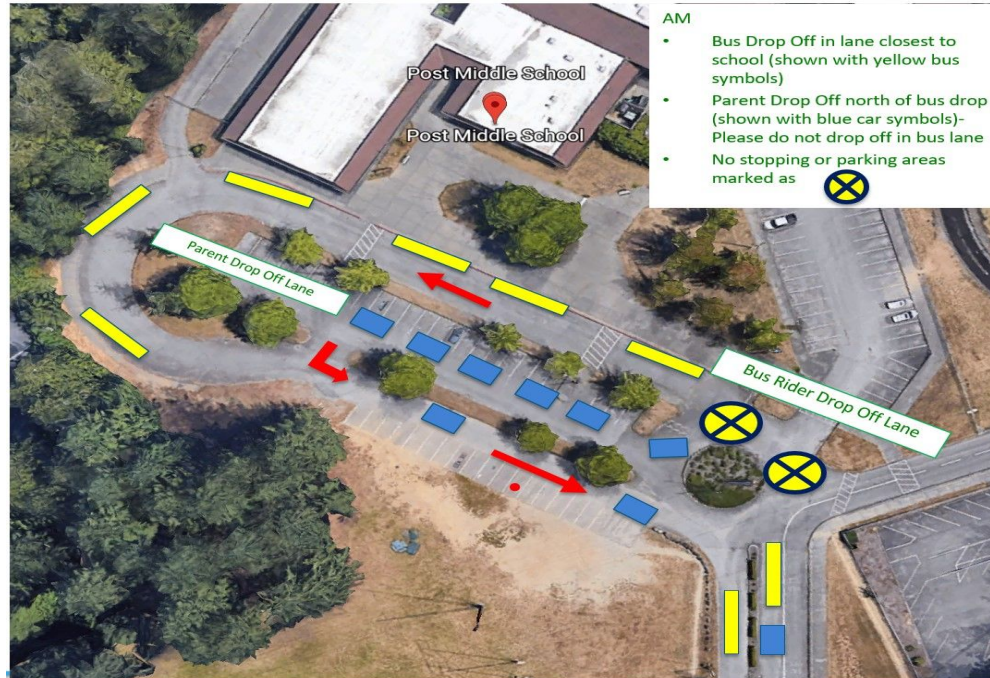
